-  Dogs must be kept on a short leash and never left unattended. No retractable leads, please.
-  For dogs to earn the right to be at the Market they must exhibit self-control when meeting people and other dogs. If your dog barks, lunges, or gets nervous in crowds, please leave them at home.
-  Dogs must be kept away from produce, plants, and other food products. Avoid sniffing, licking, and tasting. All vendors have the right to ask dog owners to keep their dogs away from any product.
-  Some children are afraid of dogs and others are allergic so please respect their space.
-  Please clean up after your dog!
